

**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS)**  
**(ADVANCE AUTUMN SCHEDULE, HART DISTRICT - WEST) ORDER 2007**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES and RESTRICTION OF SPEED LIMIT**

**Roads to be closed:**

1. **TOTTERS LANE, HOOK**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via A30 to Hook, B3349 to M3 Jct 5, A287 to Odiham bypass and B3016 to jct Totters Lane & vice versa.)*  
Length of closure: A30 to M3 over-bridge
2. **TUNNEL LANE / MILL LANE FOOTPATH, NORTH WARNBOROUGH**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – footway closure, no alternative route)*  
Length of closure: section crossing the ford

**Restriction of the Speed Limit to 30mph at:**

3. **A30 MURRELL GREEN, HOOK**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – from junction of Holt Lane to Junction of B3016 Odiham Road. In East and West Bound carriageways, or as signed)*

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Traffic Regulations) (Advance Autumn Schedule, Hart District - West) Order 2007”.

**Reason for Closure:**

Routine works/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

**Alternative Route:**

During the period of any closure, the diversion route will be signed.

**Duration of Closure:**

From 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2007 FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than the period noted above with the list of roads to be closed).

**ADVANCE WARNING NOTICES WILL BE DISPLAYED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF ANY ROAD CLOSURE BEING ENFORCED**

(excluding any emergency works)

Wherever possible reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties within the limits of any closure prior to works commencing notifying them of the detailed arrangements. Additionally we will attempt to contact any significant businesses and establishments (e.g. schools, hospitals, etc) within or near to closures to discuss the effects of the works.
