

THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(CHURCH STREET, ODIHAM) ORDER 2008

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Effect of Order:

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along that length of the western end of Church Street close to The Bury House, as indicated by traffic signs.

The closure and speed limit restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for BT works access to carriageway boxes.

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure) (Church Street, Odiham) Order 2008”.

Duration of Closure:

From 7th January 2008 for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 day). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative Route:

From the northern point of closure to the junction with Odiham High Street, turn right onto the High Street and continue to the junction with King Street. Turn right into King Street and continue to its junction with Church Street. Turn right into Church Street and continue to southern point of closure and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
