Acceptable Behaviour Contracts and Anti-Social Behaviour Orders were introduced in the Crime and Disorder Act 1998.

The Crime and Disorder Act 1998 defines anti-social behaviour as: “Acting in a manner that caused or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to one or more persons not of the same household.....”

Brief examples of anti-social behaviour are listed below.

Juvenile Nuisance

- Damage to property
- Theft of property
- Intimidation
- Noise causing disturbance

Neighbour nuisance (not minor disputes)

- Diminished quality of life

Racial harassment

- Victimisation
