



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(Hook Road North Warnborough) ORDER 2009**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Effect of Order:

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the entire length of Hook Road, North Warnborough, as indicated by traffic signs.

The closure and speed limit restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for Routine Work/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

This Order may be cited as "The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure) (Hook Road, North Warnborough) Order 2009".

Duration of Closure:

From 27th July 2009 for a period of 12 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 3 weeks). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative Route:

From the northern point of the closure via A287 Farnham Road, A30 London Road, A30 Ringway South, A339 Hackwood Road, A339 Alton Road, B3349 Basingstoke Road, B3349 New Odiham Road, B3349 Alton Road, B3349 Dunleys Hill to southern point of closure and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
