(KING JOHN'S RIDE FOOTPATH, HARTLEY WINTNEY)
ORDER 2010

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Road to be Closed:

King John's Ride Footpath at the junction of Dilly Lane and the B3016 Odiham Road, Hartley Wintney.

Effect of Order:

The closure is necessary on safety grounds to allow for footpath improvement works by Barratt Southern Counties Ltd.

This Order may be cited as "The Hart District Council (Temporary Footpath Closure) (King John's Ride Footpath, Hartley Wintney) Order 2010".

Duration of Closure:

From 23rd July 2010 for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 12 weeks). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Alternative Route:

Via B3016 Odiham Road, Weir Road, Mabbs Lane and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
