



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(KING STREET, ODIHAM) ORDER 2010**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Effect of Order:

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along that length of King Street between its junction with Odiham High Street and its junction with Church Street, as indicated by traffic signs.

The closure and speed limit restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for BT works.

This Order may be cited as "The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure) (King Street, Odiham) Order 2010".

Duration of Closure:

From 21st February 2010 for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 day). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative Route:

From the northern point of closure via Odiham High Street and Church Street to southern point of closure and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
