

THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(MILL LANE, NORTH WARNBOROUGH) ORDER 2007

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Effect of Order:

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along that length of Mill Lane between its junction with B3349 Hook Road and the property known as Chantries, as indicated by traffic signs.

The closure and speed limit restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for Southern Gas Networks to carry out reinforcement works to a gas main.

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure) (Mill Lane, North Warnborough) Order 2007”.

Duration of Closure:

From 3rd December 2007 for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 5 days). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative Route:

From the western point of closure along Mill Lane to its junction with the B3349 Hook Road. Continue north to the Lord Derby roundabout and take the 4th exit. Continue south on the B3349 to the eastern point of closure and vice versa.
