## **Licensing Act 2003**

### **Minor Variation of Premises Licence**

Do hereby give notice that they have applied to the Licensing Authority at Hart District Council for a minor variation to the Premises Licence at

The application is to:-

- ***To delete part of condition 4 to Annex 2 of the licence to the effect that "Children under the age of 14 yrs will not be permitted to remain on the premises after 21.00" but otherwise to leave Annex 2 unchanged.***
- ***To remove the "embedded conditions" set out at Part 2 of Annex 1 to the licence - this on the basis that they no longer have any relevance and the position is covered by the Licensing Act 2003 (as amended).***
- ***To correct a typographic error in the licence so that late night refreshment on a Thursday is from 23.00 until 01.00 rather than 07.00 until 01.00***
