Sandy Lane, Church Crookham – Carriageway Resurfacing – Operation Resilience

Hampshire County Council is currently carrying out a variety of maintenance treatments based around extending the resilience and life of the road network. Operation Resilience is essentially an investment in Hampshire's roads for the long term, marking a substantial shift in emphasis from reactive to planned maintenance – which is much more cost effective in the long run, making them more resilient to the effects of extreme weather, such as snow and ice, and increasingly heavy traffic.

As part of Operation Resilience, Hampshire County Council will be undertaking carriageway resurfacing works on Sandy Lane between Atbara Road and Oakwood. The works are programmed to start on Saturday 4 February 2012 and are expected to last for 1 day, during which time the road being resurfaced will be closed to through traffic from approximately 07:30 to 17:00 hrs.

However, timescales do sometimes have to be moved if we get a period of bad weather or we see that, once we open the road up, repair works are going to be more complicated than anticipated. Any changes to the programme will be made clear on the yellow sign boards where the work is taking place, and on our website: hants.gov.uk/transport. Changes and reminders of work will be put out on the County Council's twitter feed: www.twitter.com/hantsconnect, and you can also call 0845 603 5633 to check when work is being carried out.

NO PARKING will be permitted between Atbara Road and Oakwood on the day of the works. To avoid causing delays and to assist the contractor in completing the works in the required timescale, it would be appreciated if vehicles are removed before 07:00 hours on the day of the work.
