



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)  
(ADVANCE SCHEDULE MAY 2010) ORDER 2010**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES**

**Roads to be closed:**

1. **SYCAMORE CLOSE, CHURCH CROOKHAM**  
(For approx. 2 days – no alternative route)
2. **RYELAW ROAD, CHURCH CROOKHAM – Reading Road South to Champion Way**  
(For approx. 2 weeks - diversion via Moore Road, Aldershot Road & Reading Road South)
3. **RICHMOND CLOSE, CHURCH CROOKHAM**  
(For approx. 2 days – no alternative route)
4. **REDFIELDS LANE, CHURCH CROOKHAM – Jct with A287 Farnham Road to Jct with Watery Lane**  
(For approx. 8 weeks and 1 week – diversion via A287 Farnham Road to B3013 Beacon Hill Road to Sandy Lane to Aldershot Road. Road will be closed twice, for drainage and resurfacing works)
5. **WEST GREEN ROAD, HARTLEY WINTNEY (PHASE 1) – White Knights Farm to Florians**  
(For approx. 5 weeks – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, A30 London Road & West Green Road)
6. **WEST GREEN ROAD, HARTLEY WINTNEY (PHASE 2) – Arrow Lane to Gas Pumping Station**  
(For approx. 6 weeks – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, A30 London Road & West Green Road)
7. **VICARAGE ROAD, BLACKWATER – Jct with Hawley Lane to A30 London Road**  
(For approx. 1 week – diversion via Hawley Road & A30 London Road, or as signed)
8. **THE LAKESIDE, BLACKWATER – Jct with Frogmore Park Drive**  
(For approx. 6 weeks – no alternative diversion route as this is a cul-de-sac but road closure at Jct with Frogmore Park Drive)
9. **CORRINGWAY/GRAVEL ROAD, CHURCH CROOKHAM**  
(For approx. 1 week – diversion via Reading Road South or as signed)
10. **BRANKSOMEWOOD ROAD/VICTORIA ROAD, FLEET – Footpath link**  
(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via Fleet Road)
11. **BRANKSOMEWOOD ROAD/CHURCH ROAD, FLEET – Footpath link**  
(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via Fleet Road)
12. **ST JOHNS ROAD/CHURCH LANE, HARTLEY WINTNEY – Footpath link**  
(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via St Johns Road and Church Lane)
13. **BOROUGH COURT ROAD, MURRELL GREEN**  
(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via A30 London Road & Thackhams Lane)
14. **VICARAGE LANE, HOUND GREEN, MATTINGLEY**  
(For approx. 3 days – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, Bottle Lane)
15. **PANKRIDGE STREET, CRONDALL**  
(For approx. 6 weeks – diversion via Bowling Alley, A287 Farnham Road, Heath Lane, Dippenhall Street. Will NOT be closed at the same time as Item 16)
16. **DIPPENHALL STREET, CRONDALL**  
(For approx. 9 weeks – diversion via Crondall Lane, Dora's Green Lane, Heath Lane and/or Heath Lane, A287 Farnham Road, Bowling Alley, Pankridge Street. Will NOT be closed at the same time as Item 15)
17. **HOLLYBUSH LANE, EVERSLEY**  
(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Chequers Lane, B3272 Reading Road)
18. **MOULSHAM COPSE LANE, YATELEY**  
(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via B3272 Reading Road, Moulsham Lane)
19. **RED HILL, MATTINGLEY**  
(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via B3011 Bracknell Lane to B3349 Reading Road)
20. **BEAULIEU GARDENS FOOTPATH, BLACKWATER – Rear of Nos. 101 to 112**  
(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via nearby footpath link as signed)
21. **GASTON LANE FOOTPATH, SOUTH WARNBOROUGH**  
(For approx. 7 weeks – diversion via Gaston Lane, Lees Hill & B3349 Alton Road)

This Order may be cited as:

“The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closures) (Advance Schedule May 2010) Order 2010”.

**Reason for Closure:**

Routine works/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

**Alternative Route:**

During the period of any closure, the diversion route will be signed.

**Duration of Closure:**

From 4<sup>th</sup> May 2010 FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

(Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than the period noted above with the list of roads to be closed).

ADVANCE WARNING NOTICES WILL BE DISPLAYED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF ANY ROAD CLOSURE BEING ENFORCED (excluding any emergency works)

Wherever possible reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties within the limits of any closure prior to works commencing notifying them of the detailed arrangements. Additionally we will attempt to contact any significant businesses and establishments (e.g. schools, hospitals, etc) within or near to closures to discuss the effects of the works.
