



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)  
(ADVANCE SCHEDULE 2009-10) ORDER 2009**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES**

**Roads to be closed:**

- 1. HOLT LANE, HOOK (To aid resurfacing of A30 Westbound Carriageway opposite Crooked Billet) – Jct with A30 London Road to Jct with Holt Way**  
*(For approx. 1 to 2 weeks – diversion via Holt Lane, Pantile Drive, Holt Way, Four Acre Coppice, B3349 Griffin Way South and A30 London Road)*
- 2. A327 READING ROAD, EVERSLEY – Jct with Warbrook Lane to Jct with B3272 Reading Rd** *(For approx. 2 weeks diversion via A327 Brickhouse Hill, A30 London Road, A339 Newbury Road, A33 Reading Road, B3270 Lower Earley Way & A327 Reading Road)*
- 3. PANKRIDGE STREET, CRONDALL – Jct with Dippenhall Street to Bowling Alley**  
*(For approx. 10 weeks – diversion via Bowling Alley, A287 Farnham Road, Heath Lane, Dippenhall Street & Pankridge Street)*
- 4. EWSHOT LANE, EWSHOT – Jct with Tadpole Lane to Jct with Dare's Lane**  
*(For approx. 5 weeks – diversion via Ewshot Lane, Aldershot Road, Sandy Lane, B3013 Beacon Hill Road & Tadpole Lane)*
- 5. RED HILL, MATTINGLEY – Hazeley Bottom to Mattingley Bridge**  
*(For approx. 8 weeks – diversion via B3011 Bracknell Lane & B3349 Reading Road)*
- 6. CROOKHAM ROAD, CROOKHAM VILLAGE – The Street to Jct with Netherhouse Moor**  
*(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via The Street, Hitches Lane, A323 Reading Road North & Crookham Road)*
- 7. REDFIELDS LANE, CHURCH CROOKHAM – Jct with A287 Farnham Road to Jct with Watery Lane** *(For approx. 6 weeks – diversion via A287 Farnham Road, B3013 Beacon Hill Road, Sandy Lane & Aldershot Road)*
- 8. WEST GREEN ROAD, HARTLEY WINTNEY (PHASE 1) – White Knights Farm to Florians**  
*(For approx. 5 weeks – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, A30 London Road & West Green Road)*
- 9. WEST GREEN ROAD, HARTLEY WINTNEY (PHASE 2) – Arrow Lane to Gas Pumping Station** *(For approx. 12 weeks – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, A30 London Road & West Green Road)*
- 10. SUNNYSIDE, FLEET – Jct Branksomewood Road to Jct Church Road**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Branksomewood Road, A3013 Fleet Road, Church Road & Sunnyside)*
- 11. THE LAKESIDE, BLACKWATER – Jct with Frogmore Park Drive**  
*(For approx. 1 week – there is no alternative diversion route)*

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closures) (Advance Schedule 2009-10) Order 2009”.

**Reason for Closure:**

Routine works/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

**Alternative Route:**

During the period of any closure, the diversion route will be signed.

**Duration of Closure:**

From 5<sup>th</sup> May 2009 FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner.

(Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than the period noted above with the list of roads to be closed).

ADVANCE WARNING NOTICES WILL BE DISPLAYED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF ANY ROAD CLOSURE BEING ENFORCED (excluding any emergency works)

Wherever possible reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties within the limits of any closure prior to works commencing notifying them of the detailed arrangements. Additionally we will attempt to contact any significant businesses and establishments (e.g. schools, hospitals, etc) within or near to closures to discuss the effects of the works.
