



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)  
(ADVANCE SCHEDULE 8 – SUMMER 2009) ORDER 2009**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES**

**Roads to be closed:**

- 1. STATION ROAD, HOOK**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via Hook Road, A287 Farnham Road)*
- 2. ELVETHAM ROAD, FLEET**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via A323 Reading Road North, A3013 Fleet Road)*
- 3. BRACKENWOOD LANE, ODIHAM**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Hillside Road, Roke Lane)*
- 4. CRONDALL ROAD, CROOKHAM VILLAGE**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via A287 Farnham Road, Chalky Lane, Church Lane, Pilcot Road & The Street)*
- 5. ANCELLS ROAD, FLEET**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via A3013 Cove Road, B3013 Minley Road)*
- 6. FARM DRIVE, FLEET – junction only with Ancells Road**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via Farm Drive)*
- 7. HARVEST CRESCENT, FLEET – junction only with Ancells Road**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via Harvest Crescent)*
- 8. COURT MOOR AVENUE (North Spur), FLEET**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – no alternative diversion route)*
- 9. ROSEMARY LANE, BLACKWATER - Service Road between Beaulieu Gardens & Christchurch Drive**  
*(For approx. 4 weeks – no alternative diversion route)*
- 10. PALE LANE, WINCHFIELD**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via A323 Fleet Road, Vicarage Lane, Church Lane, Taplins Farm Lane & Pale Lane)*
- 11. LAUNDRY LANE, HECKFIELD**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via B3349 Reading Road, B3011 The Causeway)*
- 12. B3349 ODIHAM ROAD, HECKFIELD**  
*(For approx. 4 weeks – diversion via B3349 Odiham Road, A33 Reading Road, C6 The Causeway)*
- 13. ST NEOTS, EVERSLEY – junction with Warbrook Lane**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Bramshill Road, A327 Brickhouse Hill, A327 Eversley Street, Warbrook Lane)*
- 14. LOWER COMMON, EVERSLEY**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – no alternative diversion route)*
- 15. WARBROOK LANE, EVERSLEY – junction with St Neots**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via A327 Eversley Street, A327 Brickhouse Hill, Bramshill Road, St Neots)*
- 16. HORNBEAM PLACE, HOOK**  
*(For approx. 1 week – no alternative diversion route)*
- 17. THACKHAMS LANE, HARTLEY WINTNEY**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via West Green Road, A30 London Road)*
- 18. TWESELDOWN ROAD, CHURCH CROOKHAM**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via B3013 Beacon Hill Road, Sandy Lane)  
Road will not be closed at the same time as Sandy Lane*
- 19. SANDY LANE, CHURCH CROOKHAM**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Aldershot Road, B3013 Beacon Hill Road)  
Road will not be closed at the same time as Tweseldown Road*
- 20. HERBERT ROAD, FLEET**  
*(For approx. 3 weeks – diversion via A323 Reading Road North, Tavistock Road, Fitzroy Road)*
- 21. A30 LONDON ROAD, HARTLEY WINTNEY – extent of closure is from the roundabout with the A323 Fleet Road to the crossroads with the A327 Brickhouse Hill**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via A323 Fleet Road, A323 Reading Road North, A3013 Fleet Road, A3013 Cove Road, A327 Minley Road, A30 London Road)*
- 22. CHURCH ROAD, FLEET**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – diversion via Elvetham Road, Avenue Road)*
- 23. WATERY LANE, CROOKHAM VILLAGE**  
*(For approx. 2 weeks – no alternative diversion route)*

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closures) (Advance Schedule 8 – Summer 2009) Order 2009”.

**Reason for Closure:**

Routine works/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

**Alternative Route:**

During the period of any closure, the diversion route will be signed.

**Duration of Closure:**

From 7<sup>th</sup> September 2009 FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than the period noted above with the list of roads to be closed).

ADVANCE WARNING NOTICES WILL BE DISPLAYED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF ANY ROAD CLOSURE BEING ENFORCED (excluding any emergency works)

Wherever possible reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties within the limits of any closure prior to works commencing notifying them of the detailed arrangements. Additionally we will attempt to contact any significant businesses and establishments (e.g. schools, hospitals, etc) within or near to closures to discuss the effects of the works.
