



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)  
(ADVANCE SCHEDULE 9 – AUTUMN 2009) ORDER 2009**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order: TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES**

**Roads to be closed:**

1. **HOOK ROAD, GREYWELL - Jct with A287 to Deptford Lane**  
*(For approx. 3 days – diversion via A287 Farnham Road, B3349 Hook Road, B3349 Dunleys Hill, B3349 Western Lane, West Street, Deptford Lane)*
2. **HILLSIDE ROAD, ODIHAM – Jct with Roke Lane to Cemetery Hill**  
*(For approx. 2 days - diversion via A287 Farnham Road, Farnham Road (Odiham), High Street, King Street, Cemetery Hill)*
3. **MONTGOMERY FARM LANE, CRONDALL – Jct with Montgomery Farm Link to Dippenhall Road**  
*(For approx. 2 days – diversion via Well Road and Dippenhall Road)*
4. **PILCOT ROAD, CROOKHAM VILLAGE/DOGMERSFIELD – Jct with Hitches Lane to Church Lane**  
*(For approx. 3 days – diversion via Church Lane, A287 Farnham Road, Crondall Road & The Street)*
5. **HANDFORD LANE, YATELEY – Jct Cricket Hill Lane to Vigo Lane**  
*(For approx 1 week – diversion via Vigo Lane, Cricket Hill Lane, will not be closed at same time as items 6 & 7)*
6. **MANOR PARK DRIVE, YATELEY – Jct Handford Lane to Cranford Park Drive**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via Handford Lane, Hall Lane & Cranford Park Drive, will not be closed at same time as items 5 & 7)*
7. **CRANFORD PARK DRIVE, YATELEY – Jct with Manor Park Drive to Hall Lane**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via Hall Lane & Manor Park Drive, will not be closed at the same time as items 5 & 6)*
8. **DILLY LANE, HARTLEY WINTNEY – Jct A30 London Road to Mitchell Avenue**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion A30 London Road, A323 Fleet Road, Church Lane, Dilly Lane)*
9. **B3016 COOPERS HILL, EVERSLEY – Jct Firgrove Road to A327 Brickhouse Hill**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via A327 Brickhouse Hill, B3272 Reading Road, B3016 Marsh Lane)*
10. **PLOUGH LANE, MATTINGLEY – Jct B3011 The Causeway to Bramshill Road**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via B3011, Bramshill Road)*
11. **TIGWELLS FIELD, SOUTH WARNBOROUGH – Jct with Gaston Lane to end of Cul-de-Sac**  
*(For approx. 1 week – there is no alternative diversion route)*
12. **NEWNHAM ROAD, HOOK – Jct with A30 London Road to Old School Lane**  
*(For approx. 1 week – diversion via A30 London Road, Old School Lane, Newnham Road)*
13. **THE DEVILS HIGHWAY, HECKFIELD/RISELEY – Jct School Lane and ‘Banks Cottage’**  
*(For approx. 2 days – there is no alternative diversion route)*
14. **B3349 GRIFFIN WAY SOUTH, HOOK – Jct with Bartley Way and A30 London Road**  
*(For approx. 4 days – diversion via A30 London Road, A287 Farnham Road, B3349 Station Road, B3349 Griffin Way South)*

This Order may be cited as “The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closures) (Advance Schedule 9 – Autumn 2009) Order 2009”.

**Reason for Closure:**

Routine works/or associated maintenance on or near the road by Hampshire County Council.

**Alternative Route:**

During the period of any closure, the diversion route will be signed.

**Duration of Closure:**

From 26<sup>th</sup> October 2009 FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than the period noted above with the list of roads to be closed).

ADVANCE WARNING NOTICES WILL BE DISPLAYED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF ANY ROAD CLOSURE BEING ENFORCED (excluding any emergency works)

Wherever possible reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out. Letters will be sent to properties within the limits of any closure prior to works commencing notifying them of the detailed arrangements. Additionally we will attempt to contact any significant businesses and establishments (e.g. schools, hospitals, etc) within or near to closures to discuss the effects of the works.
