### **The Town and Country Planning (Local Development)(England) Regulations 2004**

#### **Hart Local Development Framework – Statement of Community Involvement**

In accordance with Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development)(England) Regulations 2004, notice is hereby given that Hart District Council adopted the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) of the Hart Local Development Framework on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2006.

The Statement of Community Involvement is a formal statement of Hart District Council's policy for involving the community in the preparation of planning policy documents to be included in the Hart Local Development Framework and for consulting on planning applications within its administrative area.

Any person aggrieved by the Statement of Community Involvement may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that (a) the document is not within the appropriate power; (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Applications must be made within six weeks from Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2006.

The Statement of Community Involvement is available for inspection from 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2006 at: Hart District Council, Civic Offices, Harlington Way Fleet, Hampshire GU51 4AE; all libraries in the District; and official Parish Council Offices during normal opening hours. Copies of the document may also be purchased at the Civic Offices in Fleet.
