



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE)
(THE BURY & CHURCH STREET, ODIHAM) ORDER 2010**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

Effect of Order:

All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the entire length of Church Street and The Bury between its Junction with High Street and Kings Street, as indicated by traffic signs. The closure and speed limit restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for Hampshire County Council to carry out maintenance and resurfacing works.

This Order may be cited as "The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure) (The Bury & Church Street, Odiham) Order 2010".

Duration of Closure:

From 24th May 2010 for a period of 6 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 3 days weather permitting). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.

Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

Alternative Route:

From the western point of closure, east along High Street, then right into Kings Street and south to the southernmost junction with Church Street and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
