

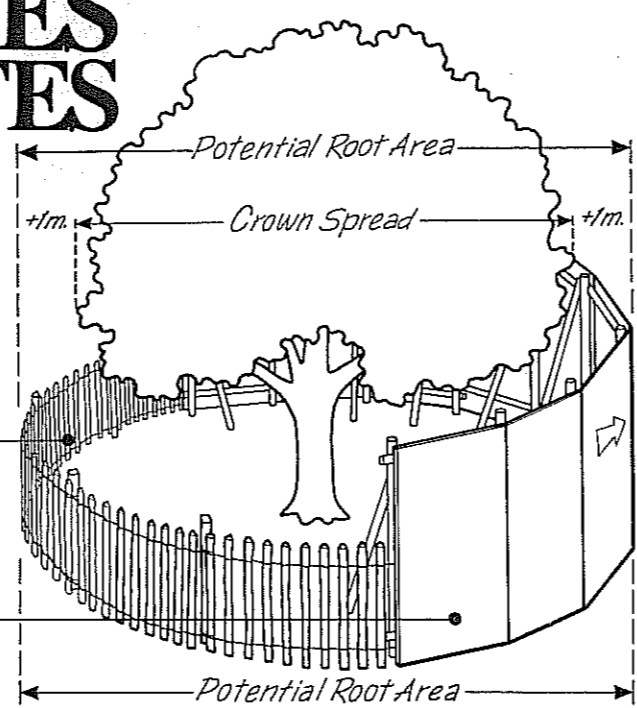
# PROTECTION OF TREES ON DEVELOPMENT SITES

**REMEMBER: A TREE IS A LIVING THING-TAKE A LITTLE CARE & SAVE IT...**

Tree roots are vital to support and feed trees. For most trees the likely Root Area is 1metre beyond the Crown Spread.

Trees should be protected by surrounding the Root Area with fencing at least 1200mm. high.

Trees in heavy plant/machinery access and working areas should be protected by 2400 mm. high hoardings mounted on scaffolding.
