



**THE HART DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE  
AND PROHIBITION OF PARKING) (TWESELDOWN ROAD)  
ORDER 2010**

Notice is hereby given that Hart District Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 14(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Regulation 3 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Procedure Regulations 1992, and of all other enabling powers, has made the following Order:

**Effect of Order:**

To prohibit temporarily vehicles from proceeding along that section of Tweseldown Road, Church Crookham, described in Schedule 1 below and to prohibit temporarily vehicles from waiting at any time in that section of Tweseldown Road, Church Crookham, described in Schedule 2 below from Monday 26<sup>th</sup> July 2010. The closure and parking restriction are necessary on safety grounds to allow for highway works. This Order may be cited as "The Hart District Council (Temporary Road Closure And Prohibition Of Parking) (Tweseldown Road) Order 2010".

**Duration of Closure:**

From 26<sup>th</sup> July 2010 for a period of 3 months or until the works are completed, whichever is the sooner. (Notwithstanding the above it is expected that the closure will be required for no longer than 1 day). The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified. Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the work is being carried out.

**SCHEDULE 1**

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**

**Tweseldown Road**

From its junction with Sandy Lane to its Junction with Oaken Copse.

**SCHEDULE 2**

**No Waiting at Any Time**

**Tweseldown Road – both sides**

From the junction of Sandy Lane for a distance of 100 metres in a north-easterly direction.

**Alternative Route:**

From the western point of closure via Sandy Lane, Beacon Hill Road and Tweseldown Road to the eastern point of closure and vice versa, as indicated by traffic signs.
