Dear Councillor Simpson,

As part of the programme of works being undertaken by Operation Resilience we will shortly be undertaking carriageway resurfacing works on Reading Road from the Frog and Wicket Public House, to the Village Gateway Feature (30/50mph speed change point). Additional resurfacing will be undertaken 53m into Marsh Lane and 23m into Fox Lane (West).

The works are programmed to start 9th August 2019 and are expected to last for up to 3 days (9th + 12th + 13th), during which time the road/s will be closed to vehicular traffic, between the hours of 09:30-16:00hrs. The road will be open during evenings and weekends. Suitable vehicular diversion routes will be in place whilst the road/s are closed.

Information signs advising carriageway users of the works will be erected approximately 2 weeks before the start of works. A letter will be sent to local residents and an e-mail will be sent to Hart District Council and Eversley Parish Council, to advise them accordingly.
