Dear Councillor Forster and Councillor Collett,

As part of Hampshire County Council's annual programme of works to make Hampshire's roads more resilient to the effects of extreme weather and heavy traffic, we will be undertaking carriageway resurfacing works on Elvetham Heath Way from Turners Way Roundabout to Minley Road Roundabout.

The works are programmed to start 9th September 2019 and are expected to last for up to 10 nights (Mon-Fri). During which time the carriageway will be closed to vehicular traffic, between the hours of 20:00 - 06:00hrs. The road will be open outside of these hours and at weekends.

During the works a signed diversion route will be in place using; Elvetham Heath Way, A323 Reading Road North, A3013 Fleet Road, A3013 Minley Road and B3013 Minley Road.

Minor kerb and ironwork repairs will be completed in advance of the resurfacing works, using multi-way traffic control, 09:30-16:00hrs, Monday to Friday.

Information signs advising carriageway users of the works will be erected approximately 2 weeks before the start of works. A letter will be sent to local residents and an e-mail will be sent to Hart District Council and Elvetham Heath Parish Council, to advise them accordingly.
