Information for residents adjacent to Elvetham Rd (Roundabout) & Reading Rd North (Roundabout):

From Monday 11th April 2023 for a period of 19 weeks

Walker Construction shall commence the construction of a cycleway/footway improvement scheme.

The works shall involve the following:

- The widening of the existing footway west of Hitches Lane to a cycleway
- The construction of a new Signalised Toucan Crossing to allow the safe passage of cyclists
 - and pedestrians across Hitches Lane
- The construction of a new Cycleway/Footway connecting Hitches Lane with Reading Rd North
- The widening of Hitches Lane southbound carriageway
- The replacement of all lighting columns and lanterns
- Re-surfacing works
- The widening of the roundabout approach on the A323 (adjacent Elvetham Heath Way)

During this time pedestrian routes will be changing with alternative pedestrian routes clearly sign posted. We apologise for this inconvenience and would appreciate if those alternate routes could be followed.

The works will require night time working during the months of July and August 2023

Hitches Lane shall be closed over the period of 24th July to 9th August 2023



Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather and unforeseen circumstance, we will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs located at each end of the works.


Noise:
