Having glanced at the proposed plan for Winchfield I note there is only provision for 6-8 social housing needs.

If the council accepts this new plan there will no longer be any possibility to build a new development in their area.

The existing Winchfield main line station will remain under utilised, the trunk road A30 with good access to the M3 is being ignored, the community assets generated by a new development with shops doctors surgery will be lost to all.

Badly needed road infrastructure will mean that narrow country roads popular with cyclists will cause very dangerous situations, with the resulting bottlenecks.

If the government impose a new NPPF where will Hart build the necessary housing numbers? there are no more brownfield sites! so "Urban Sprawl" is the solution places like Ewshot Pilcot, Mill Lane and Crookham Village will be lost.
