Consultation under Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

Winchfield Parish Council is preparing a new Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish. The Neighbourhood Plan and supporting information have been submitted to Hart District Council for the purposes of consultation, examination and, if appropriate, a referendum ahead of the Plan being 'made' (adopted) as part of the Development Plan for the area. This will then replace the current Winchfield Neighbourhood Plan 2015 – 2032, adopted in April 2017.

The Winchfield Neighbourhood Plan submission version is published for consultation from **Friday 12th May to 4pm on Friday 23rd June 2023**. No comments will be accepted after this time.


If you wish to be notified of the Council's decision to 'make' the Neighbourhood Development Plan (bring it in to legal force) please let us know.


After the close of the consultation period, all representations will be forwarded to the Independent Examiner who will assess whether the Neighbourhood Plan meets the basic conditions as required by legislation.

After this, if all necessary processes and conditions have been met including passing a local referendum, Hart District Council will 'make' the Neighbourhood Plan so that it becomes part of the development plan for Hart District and used to determine planning applications in the locality.
