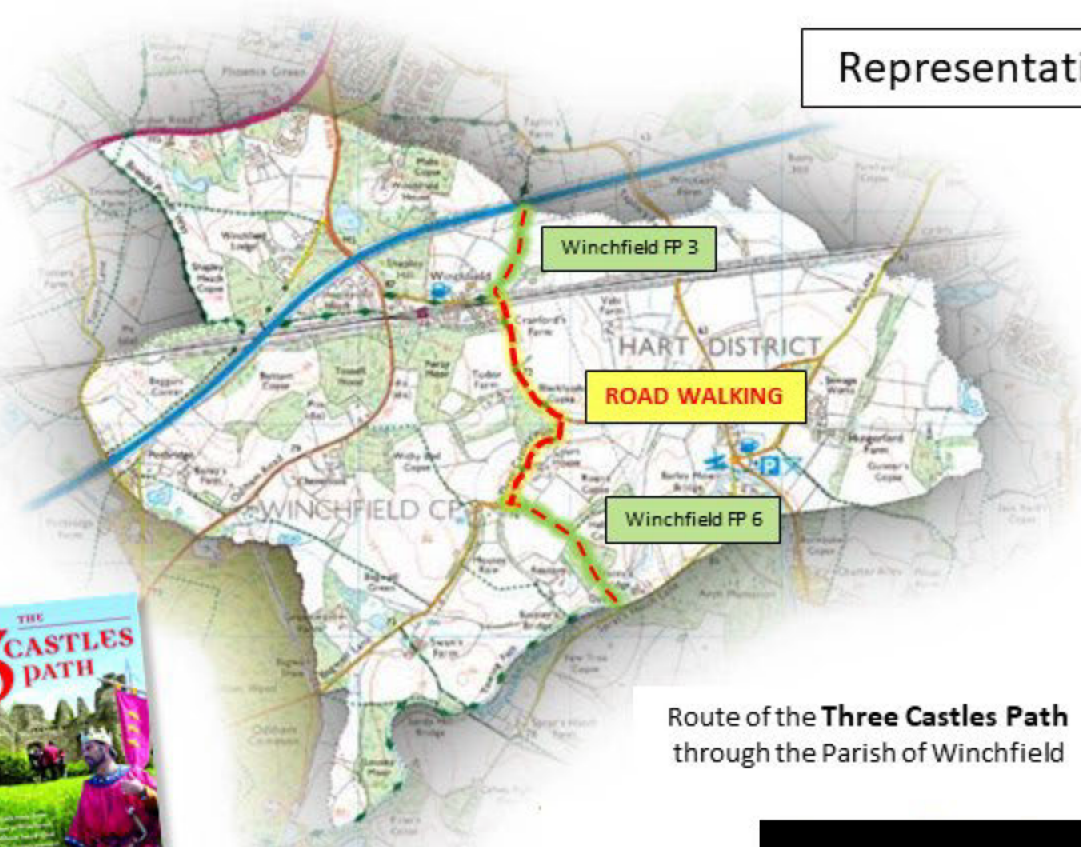

Dear Sir/Madam.

We very much welcome your initial attempts to achieve a permissive footpath to divert walkers off Bagwell Lane and would like to add our weight to that aspiration.

The **Three Castles Path** from Windsor to Winchester was established over thirty years ago. It passes through the Parish where walkers get welcome refreshment and accommodation at the Winchfield Inn and have an important transport connection.

Unfortunately as you say, walkers have to use a length of Station Road and the blind bend where it meets Bagwell Lane. This has always been of particular concern to us and is incidentally, the longest continuous section of road walking in the entire 60-mile length of this Path.

By all means, do call upon the popularity of the Three Castles Path to emphasise and enhance your chances of success in this regard.

Please include an off-road path-link from Winchfield FP 3 to FP 6 in the 2022-2037 Winchfield Local Plan. To achieve this would I'm sure prove very popular with local walkers and those on the Three Castles Path.
