## 5-Day Dead/Dangerous Notification for Intended Works to a Protected Tree

## Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation) (England) Regulations 2012 Regulation 14(2) Notification.

Please use this form when you wish to notify us you intend to carry out works to protected tree(s). Works should only be carried out to the extent that it is necessary to remove the immediate risk of serious harm. If the danger presented by the tree is not immediate then the tree does not come within the meaning of this exception within the next five days based on health and safety reasons.
