As an Event & Activities Assistant you will be helping run evenings or days where we interact with the public. This could be a large event where we have a stall or run a large event or you could be helping a Ranger run a small, booked event that either we have advertised or we have been hired by a school or group.

An interest in interacting with people, learning about wildlife and an interest in crafts/being active is vital for this role.

Your contribution will be invaluable in helping our Visitors Services with our public engagement and encouraging more people to love the countryside and the wildlife that lives there.

Training and equipment will be provided where needed.

Transport: *Though not limiting, the ability to transport yourself (either through public transport or in your own vehicle) might be an advantage in this role.*
