

Nil return and declaration for candidates at parish elections

This form is for candidates who have spent no money at a parish election. It contains both the spending return and declaration, so no separate declaration is required.

By incurring no election spending, I mean that neither I, nor any other person or organisation acting on my behalf, did any of the following to promote my candidacy during the [regulated period](#) (including on travel and living expenses):

- made payments
- made use of items, facilities or services that were provided for my use or benefit
- made use of items bought before the regulated period
- incurred spending but did not receive the invoice ("unpaid claims")
- incurred spending but did not make the payment ("disputed claims")

I understand that if I have incurred any election spending and not declared it, I require a court order to pay it.
