Nil return for candidates at local elections in England

This is a spending return for candidates at English local elections who have spent no money. The return must be signed by the agent.

As well as this return, the candidate must complete the separate [candidate declaration](#). If the candidate was not their own agent, the agent must also complete a separate [agent declaration](#).

I, the election agent, state that both the candidate and agent:

- incurred no election spending
- received no donations after becoming a candidate

By incurring no election spending, I mean that neither the candidate nor agent did any of the following to promote their candidacy in the [regulated period](#) in relation to advertising, unsolicited materials to voters, transport, public meetings, agents or staff, accommodation and administration:

- made payments
- made use of items, facilities or services that were provided for their use or benefit
- made use of items bought before the regulated period
- made use of items bought for a different purpose
- incurred spending but did not receive the invoice ("unpaid claims")
- incurred spending but did not make the payment ("disputed claims")
- incurred personal expenses (reasonable travel and living expenses of the candidate)
- authorised anyone else to incur spending on their behalf
