What has happened

Since the last newsletter the site has made considerable progress and is really beginning to look like the finished article. The first week of July is project week 24. Prior to this the external brick work was completed which has allowed the preparatory works for the cladding to begin. The lower flat roof has been completed and the sports hall roof continues to receive its final layers of IKO felt.

Internally a number of trades have been busy at work, all working together to ensure the project progresses in line with the programme. The underfloor heating in the sports hall is complete, which was shortly followed by screeding 940m² area of the building footprint.

A burst of colour has been brought to site with the commencement of the tiling in the shower/changing room and other decorating to the building.

The plant room fit out is well underway and all 1st fix plumbing and electrics installed throughout, which had been challenging because the majority of walls are solid timber which has meant the conduits and wires had to be fed in alternative routes.



What happens next?

The cladding panels to the external facades will be completed. All ceilings, vinyl flooring and tiling will be complete throughout. All of the second fix mechanical and electrical works will finish and the power to the building will be switched on to allow our testing and commissioning phase to commence.

Externally the ground workers will return to complete a small amount of drainage and landscaping works.
