

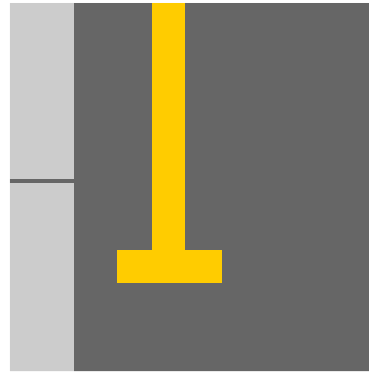


# A visual guide to where you can and cannot park



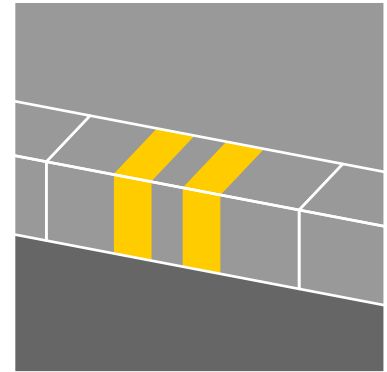
## Double yellow line

No parking at any time of day



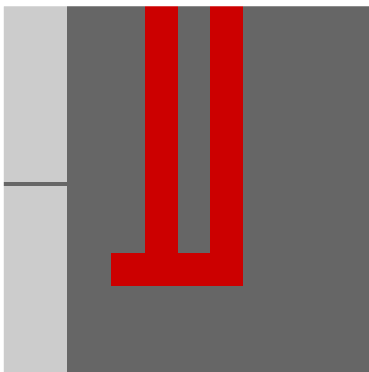
## Single yellow line

Restricted parking during certain times of day: check the accompanying sign



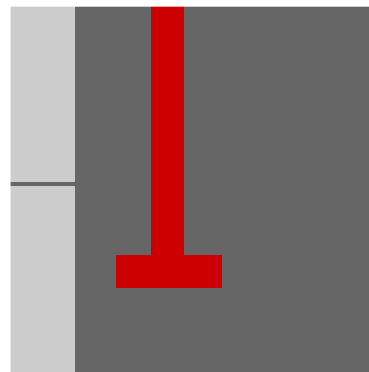
## Yellow lines with double kerb 'blip'

In addition to parking restriction, loading is not permitted



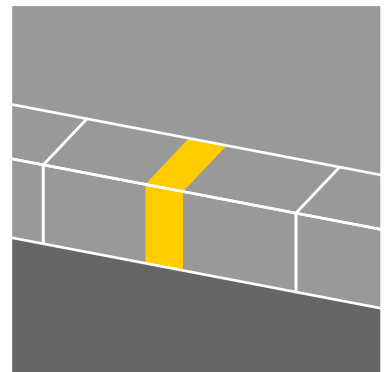
## Double red lines

No parking, loading or boarding at any time



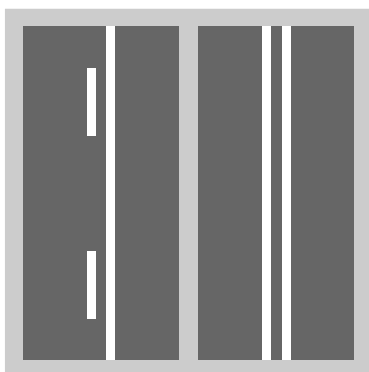
## Single red lines

No parking, loading or boarding during times indicated by sign



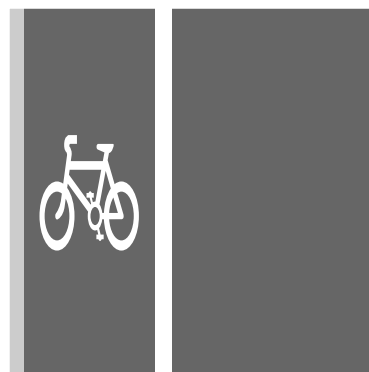
## Yellow lines with single kerb 'blip'

In addition to parking restriction, loading is not permitted between times indicated by sign



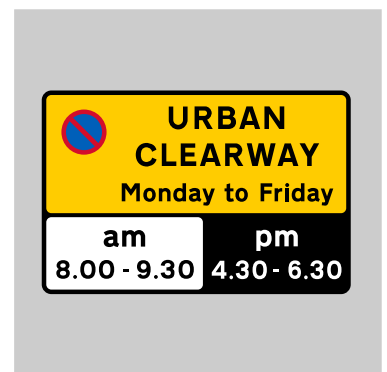
## Double white line

No parking at any time, except to drop off passengers



## Cycle lane

No parking at any time



## Clearways

No parking in the clearway zone between the times indicated

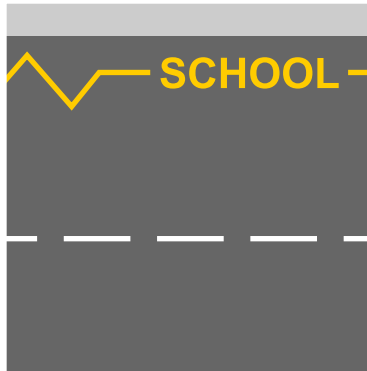

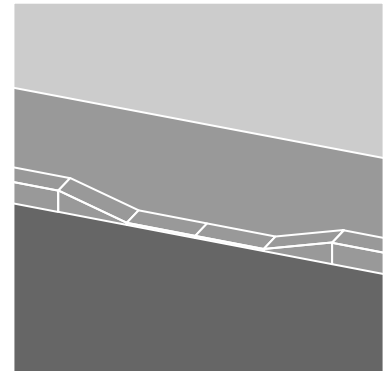
## Blue Badge bays

No parking without a valid Blue Badge



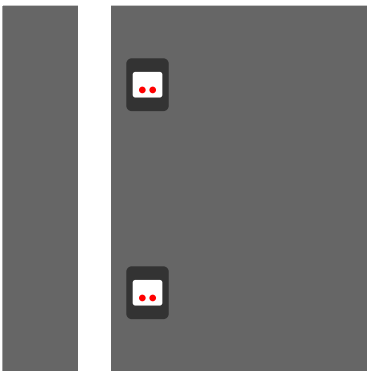
## Access routes for emergency vehicles and yellow zigzags at school entrances

No parking at any time



## Dropped kerbs, across pavements or on verges

No parking at any time (though the illegality of any of these may depend on the local authority)



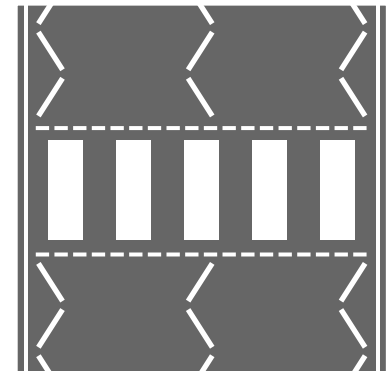
## Motorway hard shoulder

Emergency parking only



## Tramways

No parking during period of operation



## Pedestrian crossings or zig-zags on the approach

No parking at any time



## Privately owned land without any signage

Assume that it is not legal to park
