I write in support of the additional evidence attached to the Crookham Village Neighbourhood Plan

The additional evidence is consistent with my understanding of the current 'gaps'. These gaps have historically offered and continue to provide clear distinction between the local settlements, preventing coalescence. The local villages are different, reflecting their unique history and growth – it would be unforgiveable to allow them to become little more than streets in the greater conurbation of Fleet. We can't undo the loss of gaps already lost due to planning decisions (most recently the Grove Farm / Land North of Netherhouse Moor), but must do all that we can to preserve those remaining.
