We refer to the whole policy and are writing in support of it and the Gap Policy(NE01) preserving the gaps between Fleet/Church Crookham and Crookham Village and the gap between Crookham Village and Dogmersfield. We feel it is very important to preserve the identity between the individual settlements to avoid them just becoming merged into a conurbation. Infill development will completely change the character of what is now a rural area

We use the footpaths regularly and greatly value the landscape and wildlife that live there, and is of great importance to preserve what little remains of the the countryside that is so much a feature of this area. Dogmersfield and Crookham Village are very separate villages with different identities and must remain so. This gap is very important and is the evidence proves that it is supported by almost all the residents in these villages. So much of our countryside has already been eroded, which makes the gap of prime importance to stop inappropriate development.

Most people who live in these villages chose to do so because of the rural aspect and lovely countryside, and we simply do not want to be part of an urban sprawl.
