We have received assurance that the data will be kept securely and not used for any other purpose. The examiner will retain the data until we have made the relevant statutory decisions on whether to adopt the plan and the deadline for a Judicial Review has passed, which is six weeks after the decision notice has been published.

DEVELOPMENTS AT GROVE FARM AND WATERY LANE ARE SURROUNDING CROOKHAM VILLAGE AND THE EXTRA TRAFFIC THESE WILL CAUSE WILL BE A STRANGLE HOLD AROUND THE VILLAGE AND A LOSS OF IDENTITY. THEREFORE ANY BREATHING SPACE, RETENTION OF INDIVIDUALITY, WALKING/ RECREATION SPACE IS A MATTER OF IMPORTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS AND TO THE CONSERVATION AREAS OF CROOKHAM VILLAGE AND DOOMERSFIELD. FROM PREVIOUS CONSULTANTS VILLAGERS FROM DOOMERSFIELD AND CROOKHAM VILLAGE HAVE EXPRESSED HOW IMPORTANT THEY ARE TO THE COMMUNITY. THE GAP SHOULD PREVENT THE VILLAGES INVOLVED BECOMING ABSORBED AND LOSING ANY IDENTITY. THE GAP PROVIDES SPACE, OPENESS AND VIEWS AROUND THE VILLAGE AND ENSURES IT REFLECTS THE CHARACTER AND RURAL LOCATION WHICH IS IMPORTANT TO CONTINUE
