Hartley Wintney Parish Council thanks Hart District Council for the opportunity to understand and comment on the Consultation on a Community Infrastructure Levy Preliminary Draft Charging Schedule and we support Hart's intention to bring forward the Community Infrastructure Levy which was introduced under the Planning Act 2008. Councillors feel that this is a fair apportionment of development contributions enabling smaller parishes and parishes unlikely to receive large-scale development to nonetheless secure funds for the provision of infrastructure.

Clarification would be welcomed on the Infrastructure Delivery Plan which appears to list projects in Hartley Wintney which have already been completed. Guidance would also be welcome on the composition of the IDP. Is this an evolving document, and is it subject to specified periodical review and scrutiny?

As a Parish Council we would wish, from time to time, to 'bid' for funding for certain projects around our parish and information as to how this should be done would be welcome.

If more information along these lines were included in the IDP, this could become a very useful document for Parish and Town Councils alike.
