**RE: Designation of Crandall Parish as Neighbourhood Plan Area**

Further to Regulation 5 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Crandall Parish Council wishes to register the Parish of Crandall as a Designated Area for the purposes of the creation of a Neighbourhood Plan. A map clarifying this is contained at Annex A.

The complete parish has been selected for the following reasons:-

- It accords with existing administrative boundaries
- The Neighbourhood Plan process needs to consider a range of options across the diverse areas of the parish, including our 2 settlements, various employment hubs, some of which are located in rural settings

Crandall Parish Council is a “qualifying body” for the purposes of section 61G of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 which specifically includes Parish Councils.

At its meeting of 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016, the Parish Council resolved to commence the process of creating a Neighbourhood Plan and to set up a Working Group to lead the development of the Neighbourhood Plan. This will be chaired by Cllr Simon O’Connor. He will draw in a range of residents (including a representative from the Crandall Society) which we aim to ensure covers the Parish on a geographical and demographic basis. Cllrs O’Connor and Dorn have held an initial meeting with Mrs Bailey at Hart and the Parish Council looks forward to working constructively with Hart through this process.

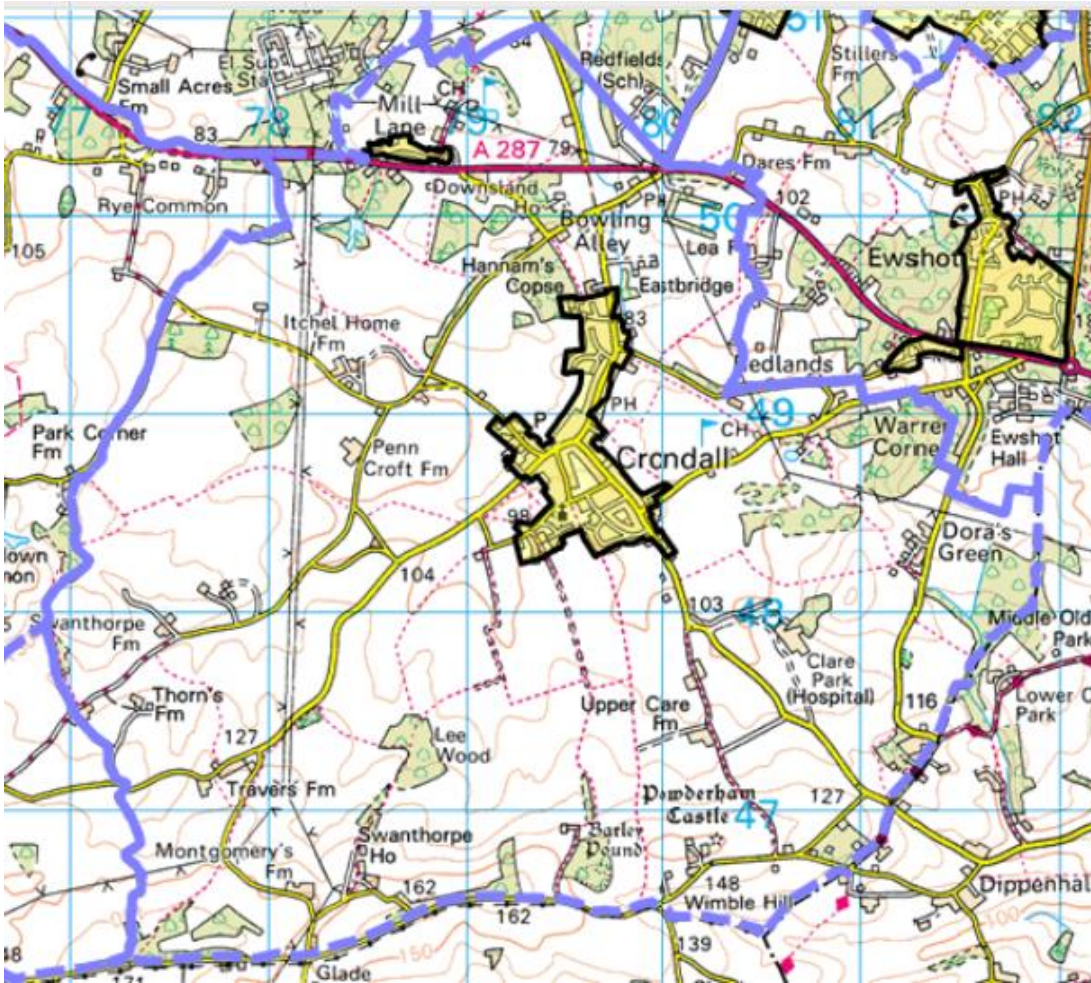
