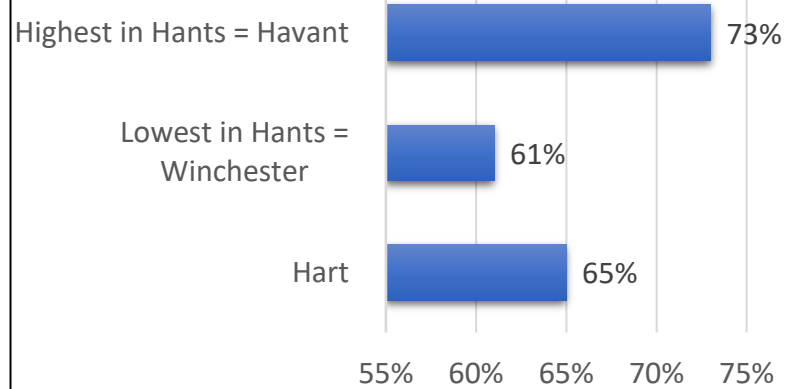


Table 2: Total SEISS Take-up Rate Comparison

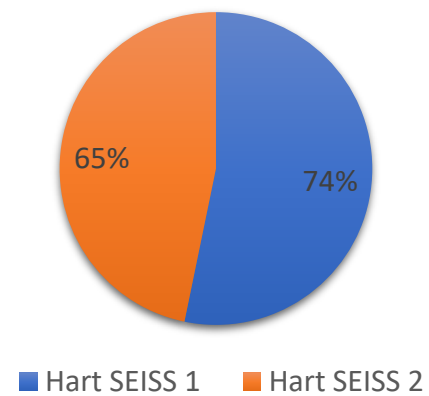


Table 3: Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (CJRS) take up rate %, furlough claims received up to 31 October 2020

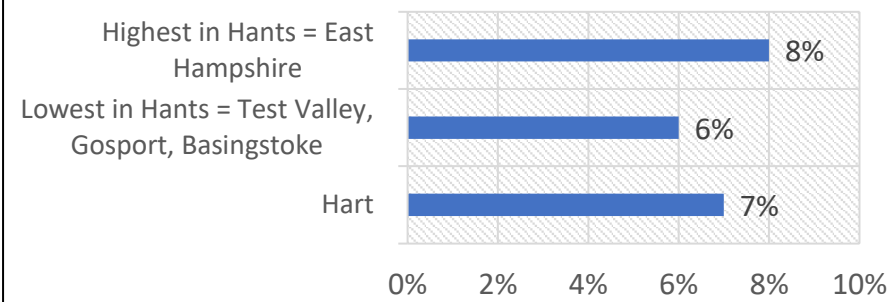


Table 4: Hart Claims Comparison

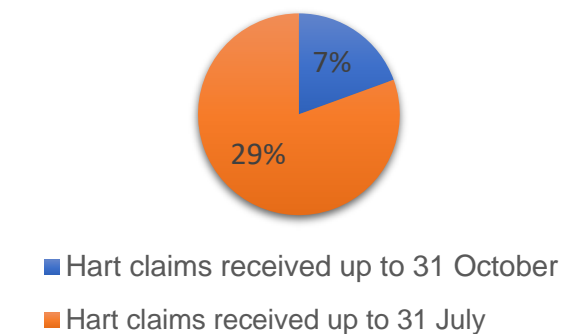


Table 1: Shows the total number of take up rate of SEISS received by 31 October 2020.

Monthly Change in November - Observations –

- Table 5: Yateley West has seen the highest unemployment rate in 16-24 year olds since September 2020. November 2020 has been the highest recorded % at 8.50%
- Table 6: In November there was a 3% increase in the number of unemployed claimants 16+ compared to October 2020. However, both the South East and GB did see a decrease in the number.
- Table 7: Blackwater and Hawley ward recorded the highest % of unemployed male claimants with 5% - seeing a 4% increase in October 2020. Fleet Central recorded the highest figure for females with 4%. Again, Blackwater and Hawley have recorded the highest unemployed claimants by ward and sex now for both October & November.

Table 5: Unemployed claimants October 2020 by Ward and age group (16-64)

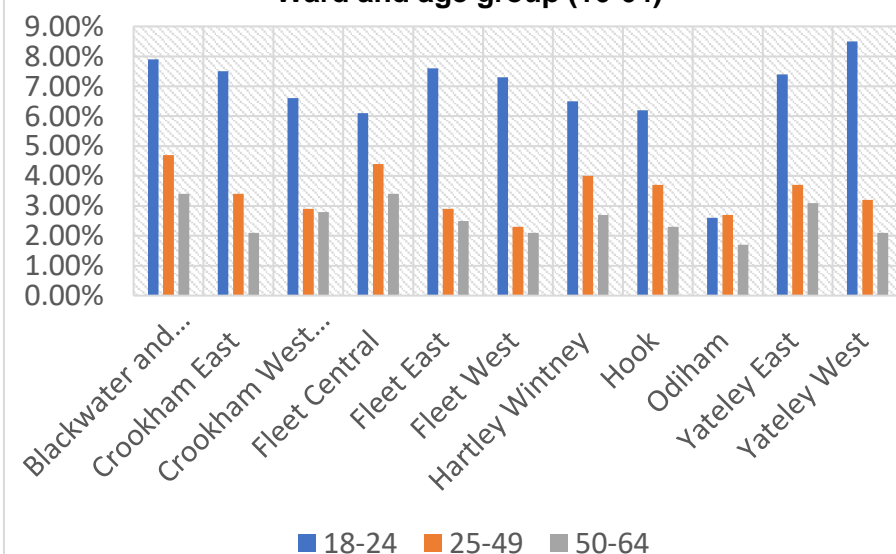


Table 6: Unemployed Claimants 16+

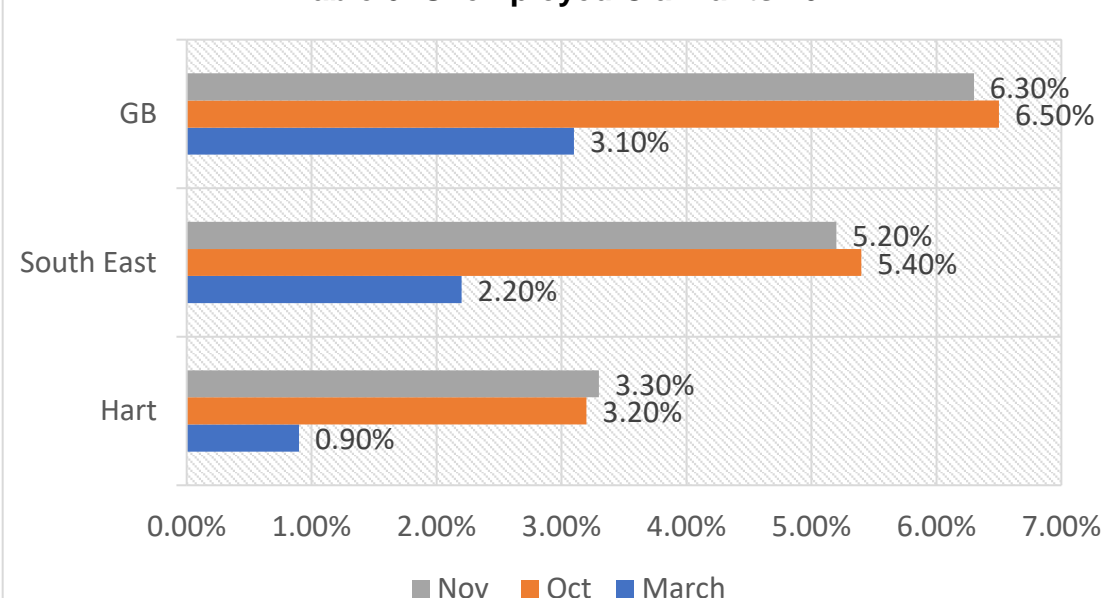
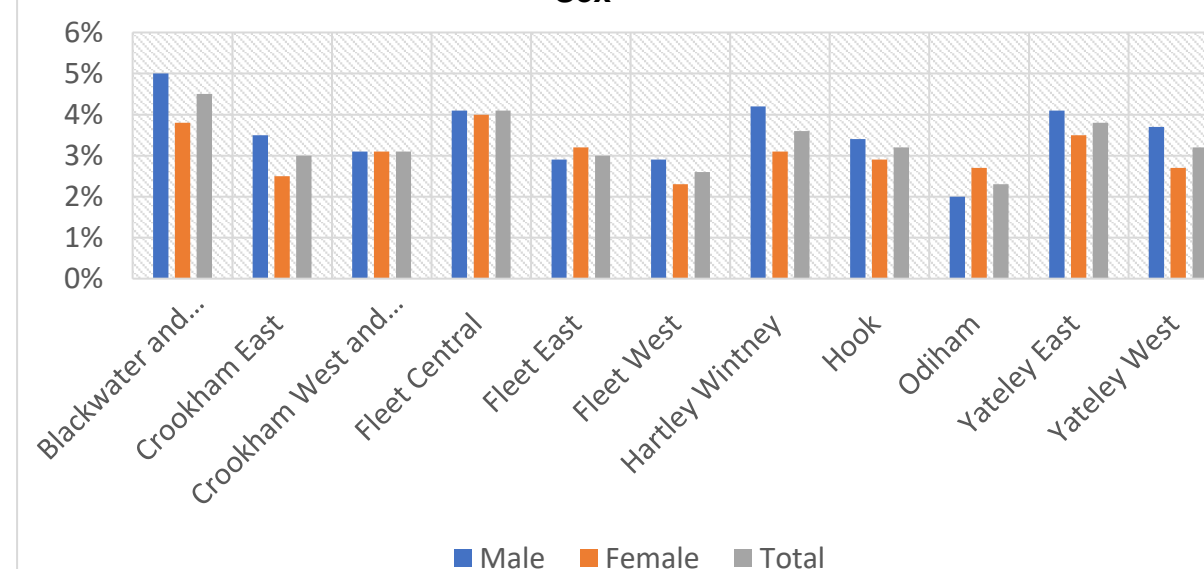
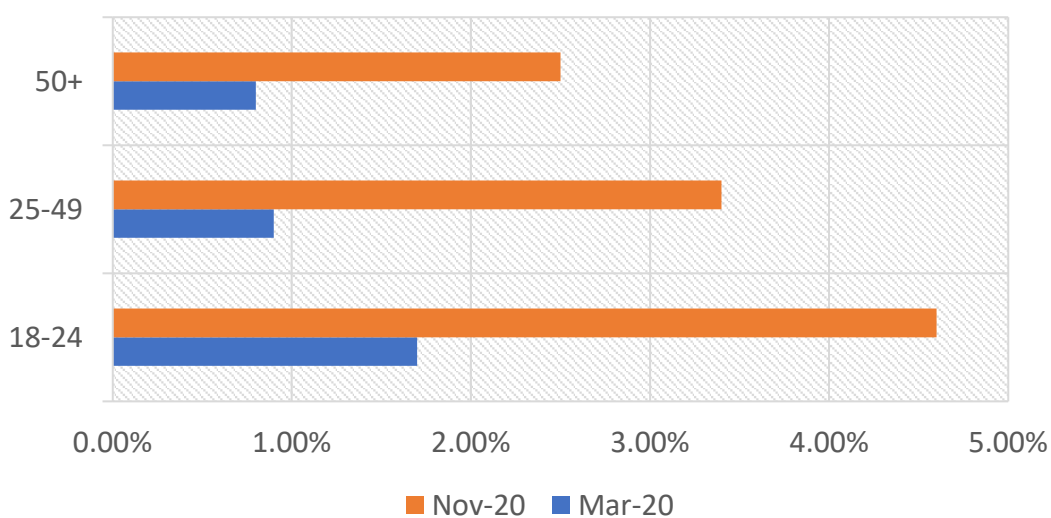


Table 7: Unemployed Claimants November 2020 by Ward and Sex
